A member of the team (preferably the Team Captain) must be at Rockaway Billiards at 9:30 AM. There are no first round BYEs in this tournament so all teams will start at the same time. Someone from your team must be at the location by 9:30 AM or your team may face disqualification and not be allowed to play. Leave early to get there on time.

Parking

Parking is available in the lot on the side of and in front of the building.

Food & Beverages

Coffee, soda, snacks, and chips will be available for purchase at Rockaway Billiards. Rockaway Billiards also offers a BYOB policy and teams are free to bring Beer or Wine. Bottles of liquor are not advised and teams abusing this option will be removed.

Greens Fees

There are no league fees associated with playing in the Cash Cups. However, there will be greens fees in the amount or \$30 per 8-Ball team and \$30 per 9-Balll team. This will cover all the team's tournament matches.

Practice Tables

Eight of the 9-foot tables will be reserved for tournament play and no practice will be allowed on them once the tournament has started. Teams showing up for their first round later in the day will be granted practice time on these tables as directed by the League Operator if available. The rest of the 9-foot tables will be available for practice, however regular table time will be charged for usage of these tables. Please see the front desk for team rental options.

Eligible Players

Players must be active APA Members, played at least 4 times during the session, and have 10 matches lifetime to be eligible to play in the Cash Cups. Exceptions may be granted by the League Office in situations where a player is new to the APA that session and they play in at least half of the matches that session. Exceptions must be requested at least 72 hours before the Cash Cup Tournament start time and players will be scrutinized heavily.

Sportsmanship

It is expected that all teams will conduct themselves in a truly sportsmanlike manner. Teams will win at the table by playing by the rules and accepting all rulings with grace. If you bring friends, family and co-workers, and I hope you do, they will be considered as "with the team", so be sure they are aware of proper conduct during a pool match in accordance with the Team Manual. In particular, note that there can be a fine line between cheering for your player and against their opponent. As a rule, cheer for your player's accomplishments and not their opponent's misfortunes.
